On May 19<sup>th</sup>, the Vancouver City Council introduced a draft resolution opposing the proposed oil terminal. You can also attend the next city council meeting on June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 PM at City Hall and make comments. The draft resolution reads in part: "...requesting the Port of Vancouver to terminate its lease with Tesoro Savage; urging EFSEC to recommend against the siting of the oil terminal; urging the Governor to not approve a site certification agreement; and urging Congress, the Legislature and regulators to adopt laws to increase the safety of the transportation of crude oil."
