# "Golden Spoon" Winning Chili

Congratulations to **Alice Rowe** and her winning chili recipe. Now you can make it too:

2 lbs. ground beef

2 - 15 oz. cans tomato sauce

1 – 15 oz. can Kroeger diced tomatoes with jalapeño

1 – 15 oz. can cannellini beans- drained and rinsed

1 - 15 oz. can kidney beans

1 cup frozen corn

1 cup finely chopped onion

2 T chilipowder

1 t black pepper

1 t salt

½ t marjoram

Place ground beef and onions in a 12" skillet and add 1 cup water. Saute until onions are transparent and beef is completely brown, stirring often to break up the beef. Add tomato sauce and diced tomatoes with 1 can of water. Add spices, stir well and simmer for 20 min. before serving.
